    - (ii) Explain fully why EACH of the strategies you suggested in (d) (i) above is likely to be successful. (6 marks)

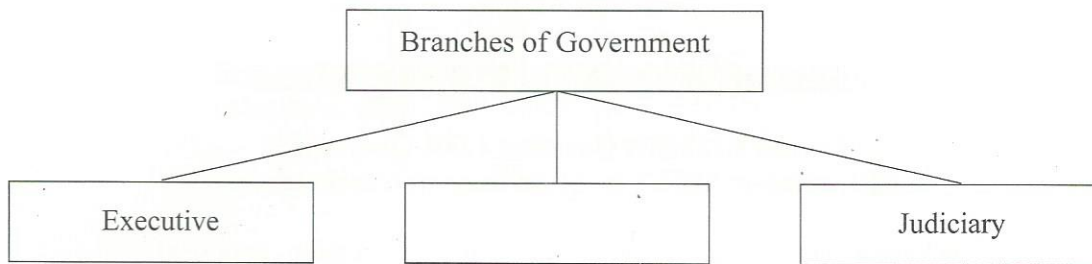

Hotels	10	8	11	18
Construction	17	12	1	2
Manufacturing	10	7	24	15
Wholesale	11	17	11	21

- (i) Identify the sector that employed the highest percentage of women in 2010. (1 mark)
- (ii) Identify the sector that employed the highest percentage of men in 2005. (1 mark)
- (iii) Identify the sector which is the largest employer of labour for the period. (1 mark)
- (iv) Calculate the percentage change in women employed in the hotel industry from 2005 to 2010. (1 mark)
- (b) Explain TWO ways in which the level of a person's skills may influence the type of employment which that person can obtain. (4 marks)

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- (c) (i) Suggest, giving full details, THREE strategies that a secondary school (administration) may implement to help prepare students for employment. (6 marks)
- (ii) Explain fully why EACH of the measures you suggested in (d) (i) above is likely to be successful. (6 marks)
